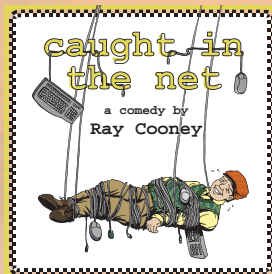

The Best Christmas Pageant Ever

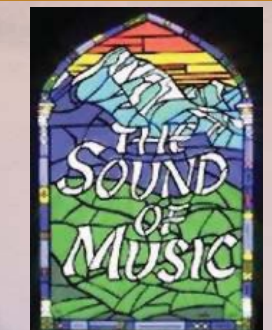

*Opening night performance coincides with the WinterDaze celebration in downtown Menomonie. This performance will begin after the conclusion of the fireworks display.

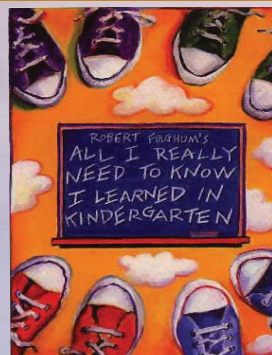


The Sound of Music

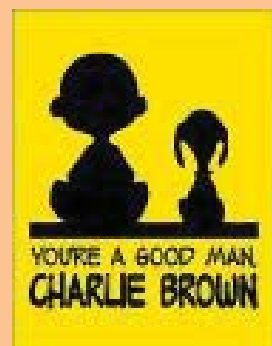


All I Really Need to Know I Learned in Kindergarten

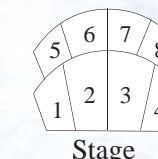
