# **Barbara Gauvin Scholarship Guidelines**

The Menomonie Theater Guild invites students to apply for a scholarship recognizing their artistic abilities. To be considered for this scholarship, students must apply and be accepted for admission into a higher learning institution. All scholarships require a completed application for scholarships and a recommendation form from someone who knows the student in an artistic capacity.

The application deadline is

**April 1.**

Scholarships are awarded to those students with significant experience and success in the fine arts and involvement with the Menomonie Theater Guild.

Scholarships range is a onetime \$500.00 award.

**Restrictions:** Funds may be used for tuition, books, fees, supplies and educational expenses.

## **CRITERIA**

Students must demonstrate merit, promise and need as determined by the scholarship committee. Students with a past or active history with the Menomonie Theater Guild will receive highest priority.

**Residence:** Preference given to students enrolled in a University of Wisconsin institution.

**Subject/course of study:** Courses leading to a degree in arts with an emphasis on music or theater arts will hold higher merit, although any course of study will be considered

**Enrollment Status:** Preference given to students pursuing full-time enrollment in courses leading to a Bachelors degree. Must show proof of enrolment to receive scholarship.

**GPA:** Minimum of 3.0 from high school or completed college work.

**Funding source:** Menomonie Theater Guild. Mrs. Barbara Gauvin. Always musically and theater inclined, the scholarship was established in her honor because she believed music and theater is a means of enriching people's lives
